Revision of Dividend Forecast for the fiscal year ending December 2005

SIIX Corporation hereby announces that it was decided at the Board of Directors meeting on August 19, 2005, to increase dividends per share for the interim fiscal year ending December 2005 (14th term), as indicated below.

We furthermore add that the forecast for annual dividends released on February 22, 2005, has been revised as indicated below.

1. Reason for the increase in dividends

The Tokyo Stock Exchange and Osaka Securities Exchange decided to designate the company for listing in the First Section of those exchanges effective June 1, 2005, and we would like to express our gratitude to our shareholders and other concerned parties whose support has made this possible. In response to the constant support of our shareholders, we have therefore decided to add ¥2.5 to the previously anticipated interim dividend for a total dividend of ¥7.5 per share. Taking the current performance trends into account, we furthermore expect to increase the previously forecasted year-end dividend by ¥2.5 for a total of ¥7.5 per share (total ¥15/year).
